

BBC Blast Consent Form



Blast is hugely aware of the special responsibility we have when you participate in a BBC activity. This form indicates your permission (and that of your parent/guardian if you are under 16) to attend events and to submit your work as part of BBC Blast. It enables the BBC to use and broadcast your creative work and to document your activity to use for publicity and broadcast purposes. Participation cannot take place unless this document has been signed and received by the BBC. Please read this sheet carefully, complete and sign the form, then bring it with you to the Blast event.

Arrival

On arrival, you'll register at reception with this signed consent form, so please allow time for registration before the start of the workshop. There is wheelchair access to workshop spaces - please contact us in advance if you have any specific requirements.

Food & Drink

During workshops there will be scheduled breaks which may include an extended break at lunchtime when the site is closed and activity ceases. Please note that Blast does not provide refreshments except drinking water.

Supervision

The BBC is only responsible for you/your child while they remain on site for the length of the Blast activity and not during breaks or at the end of the workshop/activity if you/your child have/has left the site. The BBC reserves the right to refuse access to Blast and to require you/your child to leave the site (e.g. in the event of an emergency or for conduct reasons).

Terms & Conditions

By signing this form you agree and understand that:

1. You are happy to attend a Blast activity facilitated by BBC staff and professionals working with the BBC. All staff adhere to the BBC Child Protection Policy, which can be found at, <http://www.bbc.co.uk/guidelines/editorialguidelines/edguide/children/bbcchildprotect.shtml> and will take care to ensure your safety during the hours you are on site as part of the BBC Blast Tour.
2. The BBC may use or broadcast all or parts of your work created during the Blast activity for any and all purposes of BBC Blast (including publicity) in perpetuity across all media now or hereafter known, to include but not be limited to TV, radio, online (including 3rd party websites), mobile, interactive BBC services, at BBC road shows and BBC Big Screens.
3. The BBC may document your participation in Blast through photography, audio, and video and use such material responsibly for publicity and for broadcast purposes in relation to the BBC Blast project across all media, as outlined above. You agree that the BBC's use of such material will not amount to any infringement by the BBC of any recognised right of privacy.
4. The BBC may edit or alter contributions so they can meet broadcast technical requirements.
5. Although the BBC hopes to use your contributions they cannot guarantee to do so.
6. You will not receive any fee for providing your consent for the BBC to use any of your contributions.
7. The BBC shall only be liable for any loss or damage to you or your property if the loss or damage is directly connected with Blast and caused by the BBC's negligence.
8. The BBC reserves the right to cancel your participation if your conduct is not appropriate.
9. BBC Blast can contact you on the details given on this form to advise you on forthcoming Blast events or update you with news specific to BBC Blast.
10. If there is any legal dispute over this agreement, English courts applying English law will be used to resolve it.

Your creative work

By submitting your creative work to BBC Blast or creating an entry for a BBC Blast competition, you:

1. Agree to grant the BBC a perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive, sub-licensable right and licence to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, distribute, broadcast and make available to the public the work that you have submitted. The BBC's rights include the use of your work worldwide and/or to incorporate it in other works in any media now known or later developed. The use of your work will be in accordance with privacy restrictions set out in the BBC's Privacy Policy (www.bbc.co.uk/privacy).
2. Confirm that your contribution:
 - 2.1. Is your own original work and that you have the right to make it available to the BBC.
 - 2.2. If it contains third party material, contains only material for which you have obtained permission (both for you and the BBC) to use it in the ways described above. These will include permission from the owners of all copyright, image rights, publicity rights, design rights, trade marks, trade secrets, privacy rights or other ownership rights.
 - 2.3. Does not violate, plagiarise or infringe the rights of any third party.
 - 2.4. Is not defamatory or obscene.
3. Agree to waive in perpetuity any so called 'moral rights' in your work.
4. Agree to indemnify the BBC against any legal fees, damages and other expenses incurred by the BBC as a result of your statements in paragraph 2 being inaccurate.
5. Agree that others can change and modify your content using the Blast online interactive tools.

About Copyright

We strongly recommend that you use original music created by you or your friends as using commercial music is likely to restrict the use of your work. If you do include commercial music, you will need to provide details of the track, artist, album and record label. Blast will not accept your work if any copyrighted information or necessary consent from participants are missing.

Data Protection

Your details will be kept on file in a secure environment for four years after which time they will be destroyed.
