Hi, this is Kee from BBC Learning English. Today I'm going to tell you three different ways of using the phrasal verb **take off**.

First, we use **take off** to describe removing clothing. **It's really hot here so I'm going to take off my jumper.**

You can also separate **take** and **off** and say: **take my jumper off.**

Second, we use **take off** to describe something becoming successful. I'm going to be rich. **My business has taken off.**

Third, we use **take off** to describe not going to work. **I'm going to take a day off work tomorrow.**

So, we can say: **take off my jumper**, or **take my jumper off**. **My business has taken off**. And lastly, **take a day off**.
