Hi, I'm Dan from BBC Learning English, and today I'm going to talk to you about **infinitives** of purpose.

English has something called the **infinitive of purpose**. We use it to explain why we do something. **To explain why we do something** is an **infinitive of purpose**. Why do we use it?

Another example is: **I went home to eat**. We make our sentence: I went home, and then attach a full infinitive verb – **to eat**.

This doesn't work with nouns. For example: I went home to food.

To use a noun we use for. I went home for food.

Finally, we can also use **for** to talk about doing something to help someone. For example: **I** made this video for you to learn. You're welcome!
