



DATING – Part 1

to stand someone up, to let someone down

Part 1 conversation:

- VICKI:** Picture this: You're standing in the rain waiting for your date
- MATT:** You've been waiting for a long time.
- VICKI:** Where are they?
- VICKI:** It looks like **they've stood you up!**
- MATT:** Yup. They've arranged a date, but they're not coming - **they've stood you up**
- VICKI:** It's horrible being **stood up**
- MATT:** You feel that **they've let you down!**
- VICKI:** They've not done what they said they'd do.

Part 2 examples:

1. to stand someone up. I really don't want to go out tonight - I'm going to stand him up.
2. to let someone down. He said he could help me fix my television, but he's let me down.
