### Take back

**Meaning:** If you re-start a romantic relationship that you had previously decided to end because of a problem in the relationship, you **take somebody back**.

**Grammar:** This phrasal verb must have an object. The object can go between the verb and particle, or after the particle. If the object is pronoun, it **must** go **between** the verb and particle.

She took her husband back

She took him back

She took back her husband

~~She took back him~~

**Example sentence:** Pauline had accepted that her husband was occasionally unfaithful, but when he became violent, she threw him out and refused to **take him back**.

**Synonyms:** get back together with, make up with
